Some Notes to keep in mind:

Teams dressed 13 skaters: 9 forwards and 4 defensemen. Sometimes forwards will play defense due to injuries in the game or if all defensemen are in penalty box- that happens quite a bit with small benches. Forwards that are designated as both forward and defensemen can play defense in this situation without defense rating reduction, as per rules. Bob McCammon played forward and defense, but played defense this particular year even though he had scoring stats of a forward. Mikulen of Des Moines played every single game, so he is exempt from missing games. If he gets "injured", then his ratings go to +1{4} for the remainder of that game only.

The IHL was a bus league and sometimes due to injury or other reasons, teams have dressed 11-12 skaters plus a goaltender. Very few trades that season, with the exception of Snedden and Belanger, since there were separate stats for both players, other trades had combined stats and was assigned the team that player finished with unless there was an overload of players or it would make a team short staffed.

This is a fun season in which an average of 9 goals were scored per game(note Patt Rupp's ratings) and games averaged 24 minutes in penalties. Next IHL season is 1957-58 where the Turner Cup Champions had a winning percentage below .500. By the way, the Turner Cup Champions in 64-65 was the Fort Wayne Komets. Cal Purinton is the father of former NY Ranger Dale Purinton. Muskegon's nickname was named after the Zephyr Oil Company, makers of Zephyr Gasoline in the Michigan area. Have fun.
